

This unit is an AC adaptor with XLR 4-pin specifications.


1 POWER switch

This is the power switch.

2 POWER lamp

3 FAN WARNING

When the fan stops, this lamp lights to indicate a malfunction in the product. When this symptom occurs, switch off the power



4 DC OUT connector (XLR)

The power to the laptop editor or video camera is supplied through this connector.

Use the accessory DC cable to connect it to the DC IN connector on the product to be connected.


1. GND

5 FAN

6 AC IN socket

This is the unit's power socket (3-pin). Use the accessory power cord to the AC power outlet.



Connections

Before proceeding with the connections, turn off the power to all the products.

1. After having performed the connections, connect the power cord to the power outlet.
2. Set the unit's POWER switch to ON.
3. Turn on the power to the connected products.
