
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Both the DVD player and the discs are coded by region. These regional codes must match in order for the disc to play. If the codes do not match, the disc will not play.





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

Deciding How to Connect DVD-VCR

You must take into account various factors when connecting audio or video systems:

- Types of connectors available on your systems
- Systems connected permanently to the DVD-VCR (satellite receiver for example) or temporarily (camcorder for example)


Connecting DVD-VCR to the TV using the Coaxial Cable

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To receive television programmes a signal must be received from one of the following sources:

- An outdoor aerial
- An indoor aerial
- ◆ A cable television network
 - A satellite receiver
- Make sure that both the television and the DVD-VCR are switched off before connecting the cables.
- 1 Remove the aerial or network input cable from the television.
- Connect this cable to the 75Ω coaxial socket marked rear of your DVD-VCR.
- 3 Plug the coaxial cable supplied into the 🕅 socket on your DVD-VCR.
- 4 Plug the other end of the coaxial cable into the connector previously used for the aerial on the television.
- 5 To obtain better quality pictures and sound on your television, you can also connect your DVD-VCR to the television via the RCA cable (see section below) if your television is equipped with this type of connection.

Connecting DVD-VCR to the TV using the RCA Cable



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You can connect your DVD-VCR to the television using the RCA cable if the appropriate input is available on the television. You thus:

- Obtain better quality sound and pictures
- Simplify the setting up procedure of your DVD-VCR
- Regardless of the type of connection chosen, you must always connect the coaxial cable supplied. Otherwise, no picture will be visible on the screen when the DVD-VCR is switched off.
- Make sure that both the television and the DVD-VCR are switched <u>off</u> before connecting the cables.

1 Connect the coaxial cable as indicated in the above section.

- 2 Connect one end of the RCA Audio/Video cable to the Video output and Audio L, R output socket on the rear of the DVD-VCR.
- 3 Plug the other end into the appropriate connector on the television.




You can connect other audio and/or video equipment to your DVD-VCR in different ways. The following illustrations give a few examples of the connection possibilities.

 $\succ\,$ The RCA input/output connectors on the rear of the DVD-VCR are used for equipment, such as camcorders, VCRs or sound systems.





Your DVD-VCR will automatically set itself up when it is plugged into the mains for the first time. TV stations will be stored in memory. The process takes a few minutes. Your DVD-VCR will then be ready for use.

- 1 Connect the coaxial cable as indicated on page 11. (Connecting Your DVD-VCR to the TV Using the Coaxial Cable)
- 2 Plug the DVD-VCR into the mains. <u>Result</u>: The LANGUAGE SET menu is displayed.
- 3 Select the required language by pressing the ▲ or ▼ buttons.
- 4 Press ENTER to store the language selected. Result: A message appears.
- Press ENTER to start the auto scanning.
 The number of stations automatically stored by the DVD-VCR depends on the number of stations that it has found.
- 6 Check the data and time. (see page 17)
- 7 On completion, press RETURN to exit the menu.
 - Auto preset can be performed by pressing (STOP) on the VCR continuously for 5 seconds or more with no tape inserted.



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Tuning Your Television for the DVD-VCR

Deck Control Keys

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You must tune your television for the DVD-VCR only if you are not using a RCA cable

 \succ To view pictures from your DVD-VCR when a RCA cable is used, the television must be set to the audio/video mode (AV).

1 Switch on the television.


- 2 Switch on the DVD-VCR by pressing STANDBY/ON on the front of the DVD-VCR or STANDBY/ON on the remote control.
- 3 Select a programme position on the television to be reserved for use with your DVD-VCR.
 - Insert the video cassette in the DVD-VCR. Check that the DVD-VCR starts reading the cassette; if not, press ►II button.
- Start a scan on your television or set the television to UHF
- Fine tune the television until the pictures and sound are obtained clearly.
- 7 If you cannot find the pictures and sound, or there is interference from nearby channels, it may be necessary to change the setting of the DVD-VCR output channel (see Setting the DVD-VCR Output Channel on page 23 and Problems and Solutions on page 72).
- 8 When the picture and sound are perfectly clear, store this channel at the desired programme position on the television. Result: That programme is now reserved for use with your

DVD-VCR.

The DVD-VCR uses one set of controls to operate both decks. The following keys are helpful in successfully controlling each deck.

1

- STANDBY/ON Button Press the STANDBY/ON button on the remote control or front panel to turn on the DVD-VCR.
- 2 DVD Button Press the DVD button on the remote control when you want to control the DVD deck.
 - The DVD indicator will light on the Front Panel Display to show that the DVD deck is selected.
- 3
- VCR Button Press the VCR button on remote control when you want to control the VCR deck.
 - The VCR indicator will light on the Front Panel Display to show that VHS deck is selected.
- 4 INPUT Button
 - Press the INPUT button repeatedly to cycle through all of your input sources, including the Tuner (PR##), Line 1, Line 2 and Line 3 (rear AV input).



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


Copying from DVD to VCR

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If the DVD you are attempting to copy is copy protected, you will not be able to copy the disc. It is not permitted to copy Macrovision® encoded DVDs.

 Insert Disc Insert the disc you wish to copy in the DVD deck and close the drawer.

2 Insert VHS Tape Insert a blank VHS videotape into the VCR deck.

Copy the DVD to VHS Tape
 Press the COPY button on the DVD-VCR front panel.
 The DVD will go into Play mode and the VCR will go into Record mode.
 If the DVD disc menu appears, you may need to press the PLAY

 If the DVD disc mend appeals, you may need to press the P button manually to begin copying.

4 Stop the Copy Process

When the DVD is finished playing, press the VCR button on the remote control and then press the STOP button to end the copy.
You must stop the Copy process manually when the DVD movie ends or the DVD may replay and record over and over again.

The copy is only active PAL Disc system.

Inserting Batteries in the Remote Control

You must insert or replace the batteries in the remote control when you:

- Purchase the DVD-VCR
- Find that the remote control is no longer working correctly
- Push the tab in the direction of the arrow to release the battery compartment cover on the rear of the remote control.
- 2 Insert two AA, R6 or equivalent batteries, taking care to respect the polarities:
 - + on the battery with + on the remote control

- 3 Replace the cover by aligning it with the base of the remote control and pushing it back into place.
- Do not mix different battery types (manganese and alkaline for example).



- Automatically stop programme recording
- Preset your DVD-VCR to record a programme automatically

You must set the date and time when:

- Do not forget to reset the time when you change clocks from winter to summer time and vice versa.

- 4 Press ◀ or ► to select the hour, minutes, day, month and year. <u>Result</u>: The option selected flashes.
- 5 Press the ▲ or ▼ buttons to increase or decrease the value. <u>Result</u>: The day of the week is displayed automatically.
 - You can hold the ▲ or ▼ buttons down to scroll more quickly through the values.
- 6 On completion, press RETURN twice to exit the menu.

• When naming your MP3 files do not exceed 8 characters, and place ".mp3" as the file extension. General name format of: Title.mp3. When composing your title, make sure that you use 8 characters or less, have no spaces in the name, and avoid the use of special characters including: (.,/\,=,+).

• Use a decompression transfer rate of at least 128 Kbps when recording MP3 files.

Sound quality with MP3 files basically depends on the rate of compression/decompression you choose. Getting audio CD quality sound requires an analog/digital sampling rate (conversion to MP3 format) of at least 128 Kbps and up to 160 Kbps. However, choosing higher rates, like 192 Kbps or more, only rarely give better sound quality. Conversely, files with sampling rates below 128 Kbps will not be played properly.

· Do not try recording copyright protected MP3 files.

Certain "securized" files are encrypted and code protected to prevent illegal copying. These files are of the following types: Windows MediaTM (registered trade mark of Microsoft Inc) and SDMITM (registered trade mark of The SDMI Foundation). You cannot copy such files.



- If you press the button while in the STEREO mode, the selection alternates between STEREO and 4 STEREO.








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Problems and Solutions (VCR)

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Troubleshooting Guide (DVD)

Before contacting the Samsung after-sales service, perform the following simple checks.

Problem	Explanation/Solution
No power	 Check that the power plug is connected to a wall outlet. Have you pressed the STANDBY/ON button?
You cannot insert a video cassette	 A video cassette can only be inserted with the window side up and the safety tab facing you.
The television programme was not recorded	 Check the DVD-VCR aerial connections. Is the DVD-VCR tuner properly set? Check if the safety tab is intact on the cassette.
Timer recording was unsuccessful	 Was the STANDBY/ON button pressed to activate the timer? Re-check the recording start/stop time settings. If there was a power failure or interruption during timer recording, the recording will have been cancelled.
No playback picture or the picture is distorted	• Check to see if you are using a prerecorded tape.
You cannot see normal broadcasts	 Check the TUNER/EXTERNAL setting. It should be on TUNER. Check the TV/VCR aerial connections.
Noise bars or streaks on playback	 Press the PROG/TRK (▲ or ▼) buttons to minimize this effect.
When the I button is pressed during playback, the still picture has severe "noise bars" streaks	 A still picture may have "noise bars", depending on the condition of the tape. Press the PROG/TRK (▲ or ▼) buttons during SLOW motion to minimize this effect.
Video Head Cleaning	 If poor pictures appear on a variety of cassettes, the video heads may need cleaning. This is not a common problem and unless it appears, the heads should not be cleaned. When cleaning the video heads, read all instructions provided with the head cleaning cassette. Incorrect head cleaning can permanently damage the video heads.
